SEPA REQUEST-TO-PAY (PRINCIPLES)


The SRTP is a messaging scheme. It is not a payment means or a payment instrument or a payment scheme, but a Way to request a payment from a payee side.

Payee

The initiator of an SRTP process and usually the beneficiary of the funds transferred in the resulting payment flow.

Payee's SRTP Service Provider (who has adhered to the Scheme):

Usually represented by a PSP but since the SRTP can be part of end-to-end commerce processes, also other non-PSP entities can assume this role.



Payer:

It represents the party to whom the SRTP is addressed, and the originator of the funds transferred in the resulting payment flow.

Payer's SRTP Service Provider (who has adhered to the Scheme):

Usually represented by a PSP but also other non-PSP entities can assume this role.



SEPA REQUEST-TO-PAY (ORIGINS)




- November 2016: A first Euro Retail Payment Board (ERPB) Working Group on "E-invoicing solutions related to retail payments" presented its report to the ERPB
- 2017: The ERPB WG continued the work with a view to support the development of harmonised E-Invoicing Presentment & Payment (EIPP) services with pan-European reach for consumers and businesses



- Beginning of 2018: The E-Invoicing Presentment & Payment (EIPP) Multi-Stakeholder Group, commissioned by the ERPB, is launched and driven by the European Payment Council (EPC) = Business Justification / Message Definition Reports, and decision to use ISO 20022 pain.013 & pain.014
- Beginning of 2019: The Request-To-Pay (RTP) Multi-Stakeholder Group (RTP MSG) is launched by the EPC, in response to an invitation from the ERPB
- November 2019: Publication of the Request-to-Pay Specifications for a standardisation framework = Roles and responsibilities / use cases taxonomy / options (accept now/later, pay now/later...) / channel agnostism / 4 corners model
- November 2020: Publication of the SEPA Request-To-Pay Rulebook V1.0

- Onboarding of new Participants from end of 2025 / beginning of 2026 incl. RTSP
- Publication of a Clarification Paper (S1 2026)
- No new release in 2026 (no change request)
- Deployment strategy

- Scheme manager:
 - Rulebook management,
 - Liability Framework
- Reachability / Interoperability (EDS)
- Homologation / automated certification
- Scheme governance
